The 25th April is black day for Nepali people, a huge earthquake killed more than 8,800 people and injured more than 23,000. It occurred at 11:56 NST on 25 April, with a magnitude of 7.8M. This terrible earthquake that has devastated the country, with thousands of



victims, wounded, displaced and countless children, women and men without medical care, food, clothing and a roof to shelter.
